### **About Tutors United**

### **What is our curriculum for?**

Our tutors are tasked with delivering tutorials to small groups of six pupils (aged 8-11) after-school in community centres. Each year we take on a new cohort of university students who are both nervous and excited to start their tutoring journey with Tutors United. In order to ensure they're delivering high quality lessons to our amazing pupils and to also minimise their workload, they teach from our bespoke curriculum which means they don't need to worry about creating their own lesson plans and all pupils receive the same calibre of lessons. This is where YOU come in!

Our bespoke curriculum was developed by a qualified primary school teacher and was designed around the National Curriculum; it follows a spiral pattern so that topics are covered multiple times throughout the year with increasing difficulty for maximum understanding and knowledge retention. In Maths, pupils cover a range of topics that will be included in their KS2 SATs from pesky percentages to tricky fractions; in English, they look at a range of different text types/styles of writing, all while keeping a solid focus on the vital SPAG they will need in their SATs and beyond.

### **What are we looking for?**

We are looking for energetic, enthusiastic and experienced Maths and English teachers who can annually observe and review our lesson plans, assessments and grading criterion to ensure that the content is diverse, engaging and most importantly, in line with the national curriculum.

Currently, we internally monitor and adapt our curriculum, annually adding in new English modules and making sure that our Maths lessons are fun and engaging while ensuring our lessons mirror what pupils should be learning at school. One of our main goals for our next academic year is to ensure that our lessons (specifically English) reflect the diversity of our pupils and that we remain on top of any changes in the National Curriculum.

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So, we would like our new curriculum auditors to:

- Annually review and develop new diverse modules for our pupils to learn in both English and Maths (ensuring that any new content is adaptable to online teaching)
- Quality check that our existing content is consistent with the National Curriculum
- Review and adjust our assessments to ensure we are testing pupils effectively
- Review and adjust our grading criteria to ensure we are assessing pupils' progress accurately

### **How much time is needed?**

As we will only be reviewing the curriculum once a year, an annual review meeting will be held with TU and the curriculum audit team to go over the existing materials and discuss any changes/additions to be made. As a curriculum auditor, you will be paid £150 per annual review meeting.
