## About Tutors United

## What is the tutor training for?

Our tutors are tasked with delivering tutorials to small groups of six pupils after-school in community centres for pupils aged 8 - 11. Each year we take on a new cohort of university students who are both nervous and excited to start their tutoring journey with Tutors United. In September we will have a cohort of approximately 60 new tutors; however, before we can send our keen tutors out to deliver tuition, we need to ensure they are well trained. This is where YOU come in!

All tutors will deliver Maths and English lessons from our curriculum, but of course, a pre-planned lesson does not guarantee high-quality teaching. The tutor training should ensure that tutors are confident delivering lessons, and understand how to teach the core subjects, manage a classroom, and instil a love of learning in their pupils to accelerate pupil progress.

## What are we looking for?

We are looking for energetic, enthusiastic and engaging Maths and English teachers who can deliver our tutor training and provide our tutors with the tools they need to become the best tutors.

Our current tutor training package, delivered by Maths and English teachers, covers:

- Building relationships and engagement
- Understanding Maths and English
- Maths and English modelling
- Behaviour management and praise
- Differentiation
- Assessment for learning
- Lesson scenarios

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We would like our new tutor training team to help with updating the training content and activities and be ready to deliver it in the new academic year!

### How much time is needed?

Our tutor training takes place in January and is always held on a weekend - you are in the classroom Monday - Friday after all. Delivery of the tutor training is over one full day (10am - 4.30pm) on either a Saturday or Sunday. Don't worry; we have you covered; lunch is provided if we can do in-person training! 😊
